[Scene: A beautifully decorated church hall with a nativity scene at the front. The audience is seated, eagerly awaiting the start of the program.]

Introduction: Good evening, everyone! Welcome to our special Christmas carols night, "The Story of Christmas Retold." Tonight, we invite you to embark on a magical journey through the timeless story of Christmas.

We will explore the biblical narrative of Jesus' birth and life, and experience it through the unique perspectives of different generations. From the innocent wonder of our youngest children to the seasoned reflections of our elders, each group will share their heartfelt interpretations of this cherished story under the backdrop of biblical interpretation.

So, sit back, relax, and let the spirit of or Lord Christ fill your hearts as we celebrate this joyous season together. Let's begin our journey with the Kids Kingdom.

SCENE 1

[Scene: Little Children gathered around a Teacher (seated on the floor). The Rabbi/teacher is telling a story before Jesus is born, while Mary was about to give birth.] (8 - 10 kids gathered)

Narrator/Host: And I will put enmity Between you and the woman, And between your seed and her Seed; He shall bruise your head, And you shall bruise His heel (Genesis 3:3).

Child: What does that mean?

Narrator/Host: It is the story of the redemption of the Children of Adam, of Abraham, of Israel, the Children of God from all ends of the earth. All tribes and all nations. The Lord, our God will send a saviour, the "Messiah" "Christos," the anointed one, he will set us free from the evil one and we will one day return back to the Garden of Eden to be with God. One day the Christ will come and we will gather in masses to worship him.

Child: It will be a Christ Mass!

[All the kinds will exclaim 'Christmas']

Narrator/Host: Silly little kids, it's Christ mass, not Christmas (laughing). When that day some, we will dance in praise and in worship and will sing songs.

SCENE 2

Narrator/Host: I hear voices, I hear voices on high, they sound sound like Angels, like a multitude of the

SCENE 5

[Scene: Two people talking along the road.]

Narrator/Host/Communion: Gather around, my friends, and let me tell you the story of our Lord Jesus Christ, as it was told to me by those who walked with him and witnessed his miracles.

Many years ago, in a humble town called Bethlehem, a child was born under the most extraordinary circumstances. His name was Jesus, and from the moment of his birth, it was clear that he was no ordinary child. Shepherds and wise men came from afar, guided by a star, to honor him.

As he grew, Jesus showed wisdom beyond his years. He spoke of love, compassion, and the kingdom of God. He healed the sick, gave sight to the blind, and even raised the dead. His teachings were simple yet profound, and they touched the hearts of all who heard them.

But not everyone welcomed his message. The authorities saw him as a threat, and he was betrayed by one of his own disciples. Jesus was arrested, tried, and crucified. It was a dark day, and his followers were filled with despair.
